As a result of hardships caused to our community due to the COVID-19 pandemic, UBC wishes to direct a portion of our funds to charities or nonprofit organizations who assist in addressing needs resulting from COVID-19. Every adult UBC member is invited to request a donation of \$300 to a 501(c)(3) organization by emailing the official name and website of their selected organization to covid19response@ubcaustin.org or by calling the UBC office at (512) 478-8559, extension 200. In response to the current pandemic, University Baptist Church has expanded its benevolence program to provide financial assistance to those affected by COVID-19. **If you are living in the Austin area and have lost income or face unexpected expenses because of the pandemic, we invite you to request assistance with rent, utilities, medical bills, and similar expenses.** We can provide up to \$500 per applicant. Payments will be made directly to your landlord, utility company, or other creditor.

1. Your name and contact information
2. A brief statement about your need
3. The amount of assistance you are requesting
4. A copy of the bill or lease showing the name and address where the bill should be paid
