Worshipping Together Postponed

Previously, the COVID-19 Response Team announced a tentative date of July 26 for resuming in-person worship services. Since then, the pandemic in Austin has worsened. The city is now in Stage 4, and it seems likely we will move to Stage 5, the highest risk level. For the safety of all our members and staff, we have cancelled plans to hold in-person worship services on July 26. Instead, we intend to wait until Austin returns to Stage 3 and then reevaluate the situation. Many of us are feeling the stress of isolation, and we all are eager for the day when we can worship and fellowship together again. Our first priority, however, is to ensure that we can do so safely.
